We applaud the Environmental Protection Agency's decision to appoint Dr. Alfredo "Al" Armendariz as the new administrator for Region VI, which covers operations in Texas, Louisiana, Arkansas, New Mexico and Oklahoma.

Dr. Armendariz, an El Paso native, is currently a professor in the School of Engineering at Southern Methodist University in Dallas. He graduated from Coronado High School, he is an MIT-trained chemical engineer with M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in environmental engineering.
